

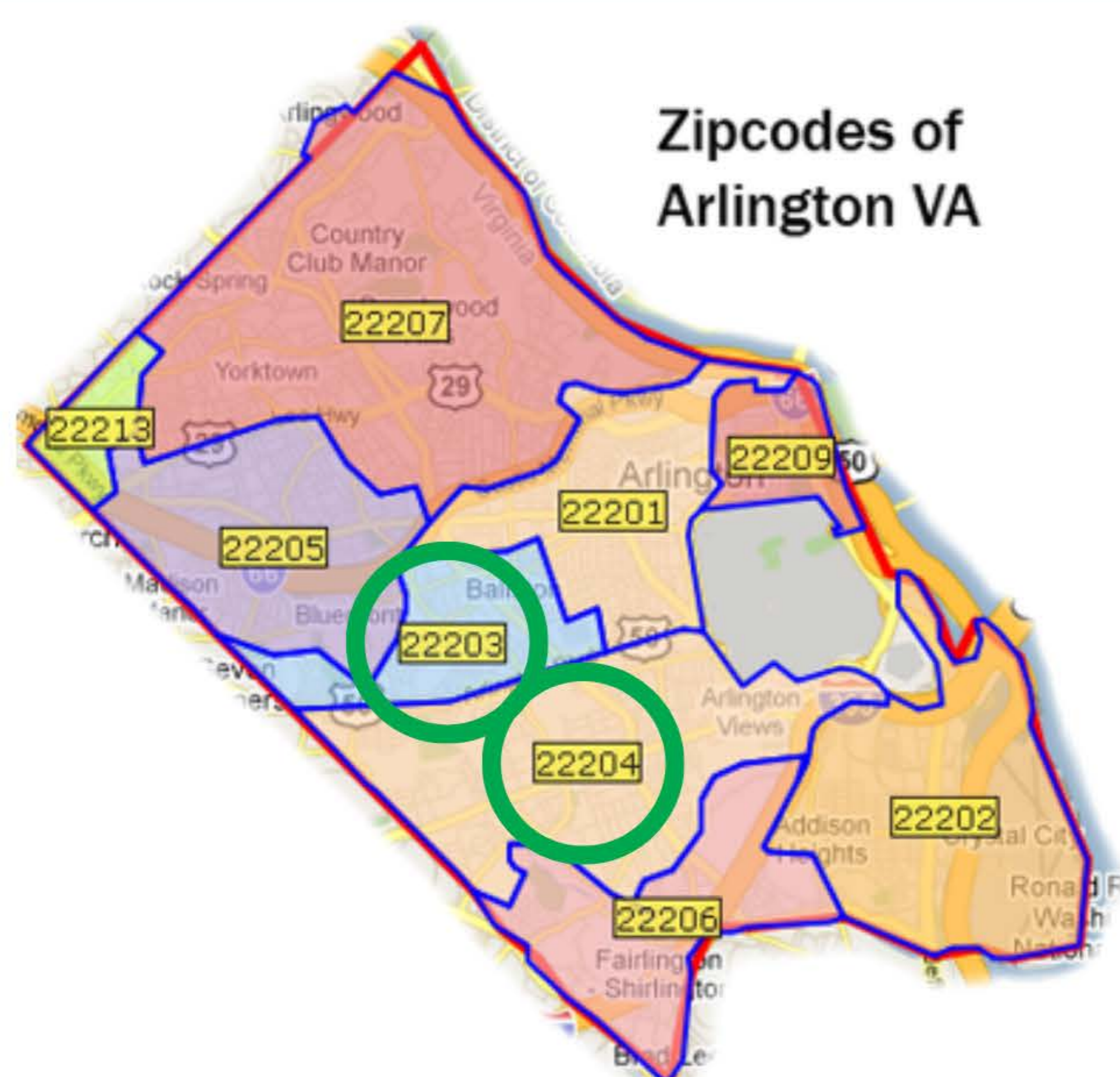

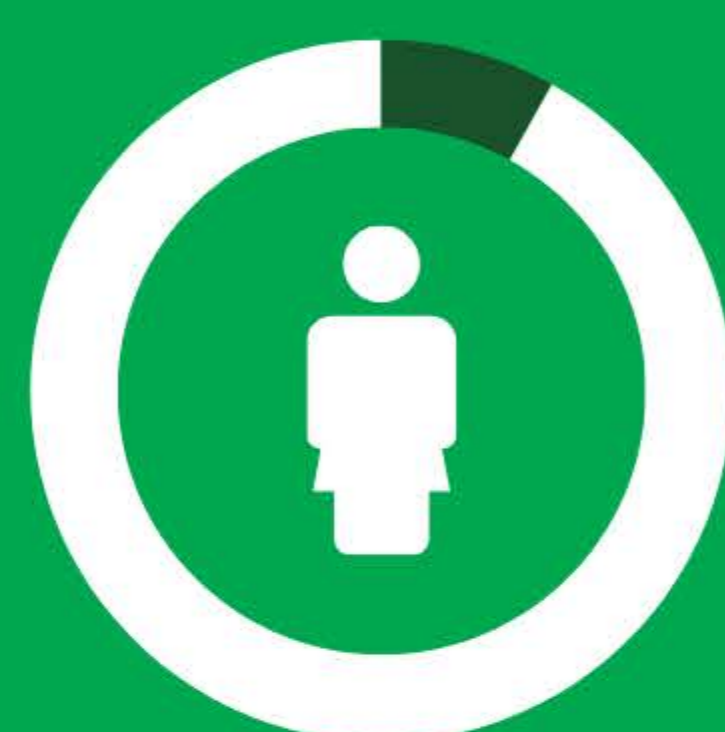

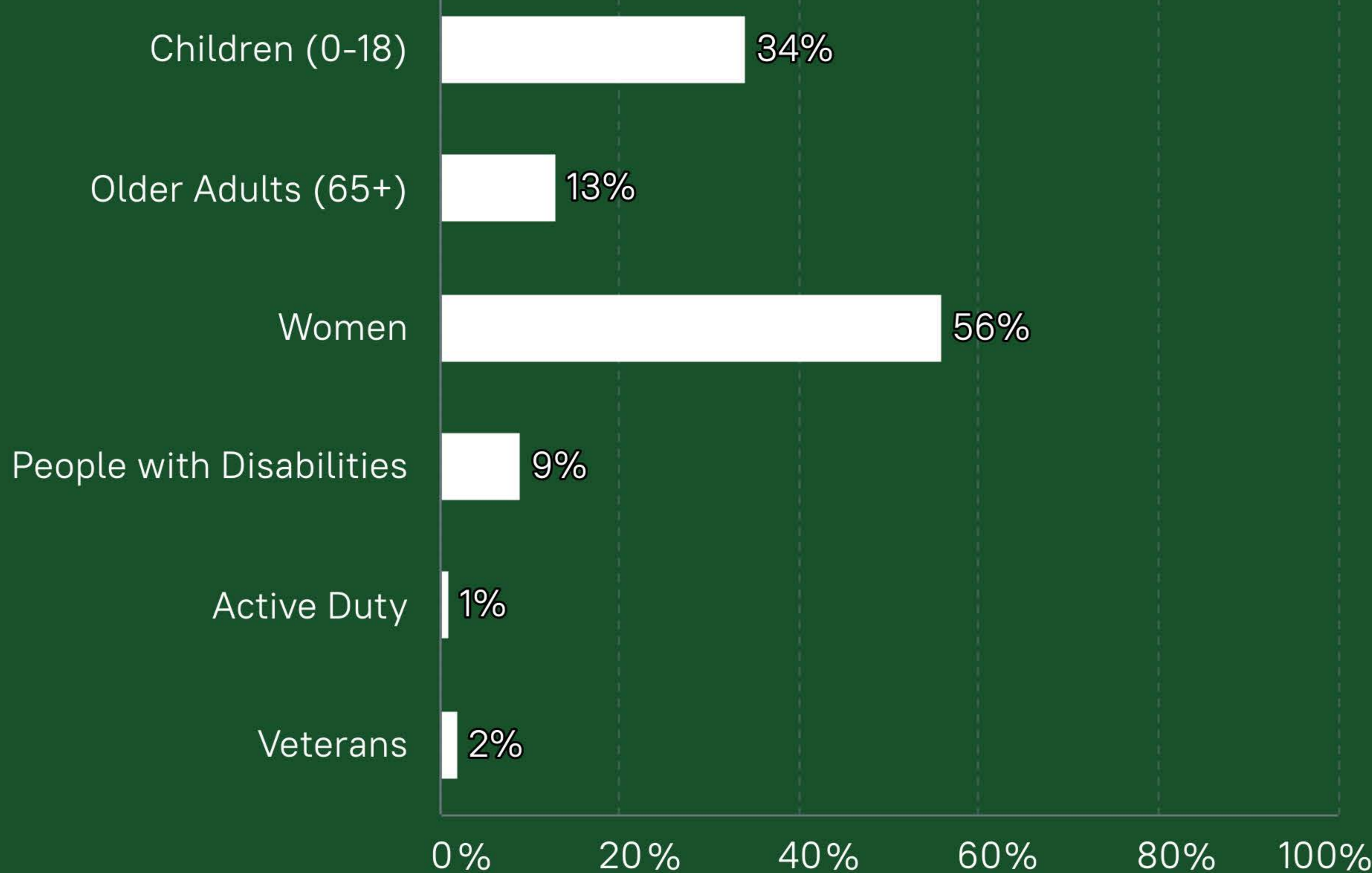

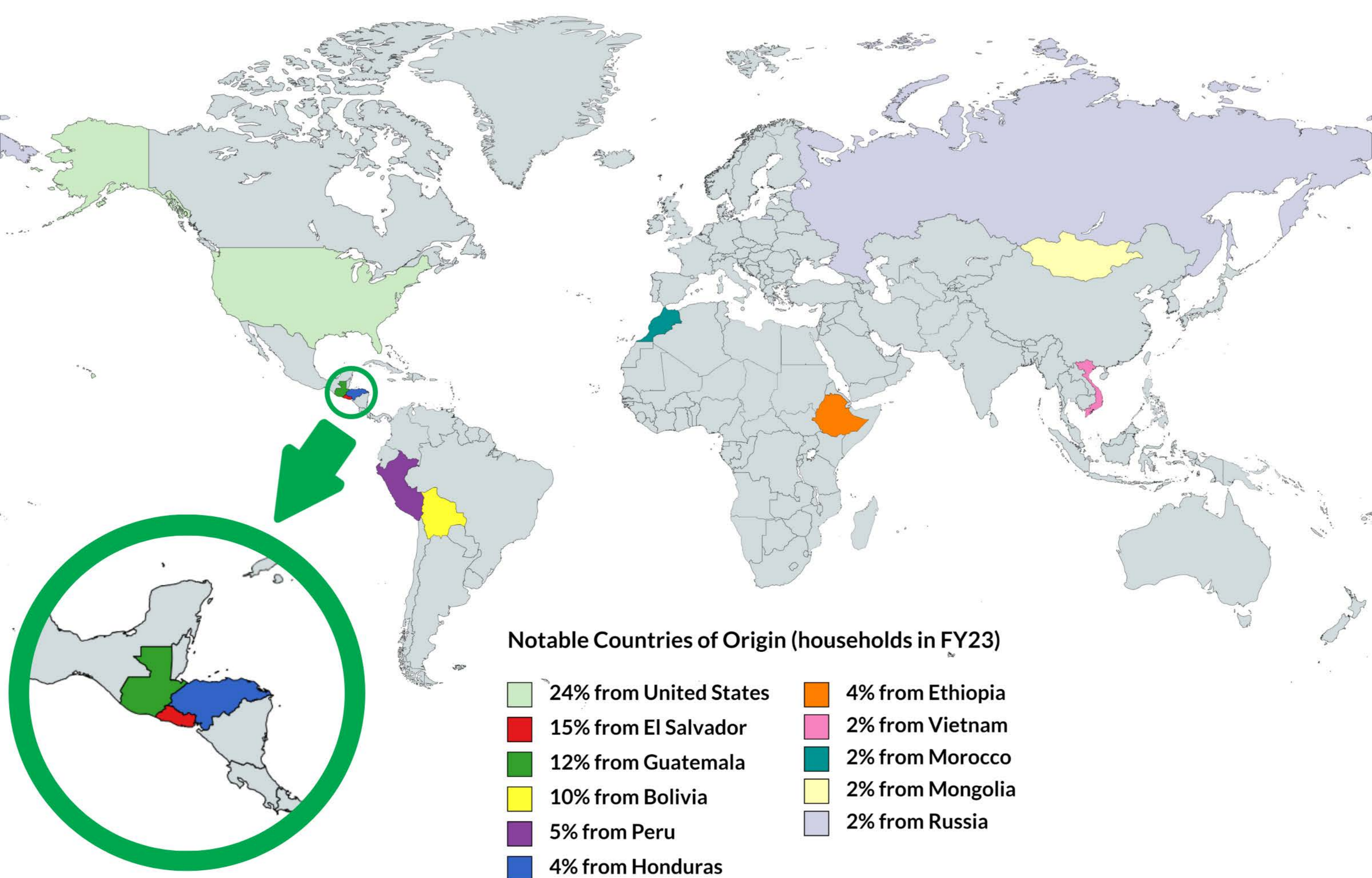

INSECURITY

53% Hispanic/Latino

53% of AFAC households in FY23 were **Hispanic or Latino** - compared to 16% of Arlington.

DISPROPORTIONATELY IMPACTS

20% Black or African American

20% of AFAC households in FY 23 were **Black or African American**- compared to 9% of Arlington.

COMMUNITIES OF COLOR

12% white

12% of AFAC households in FY23 were **white** - compared to 67% of Arlington.

57% did not have children

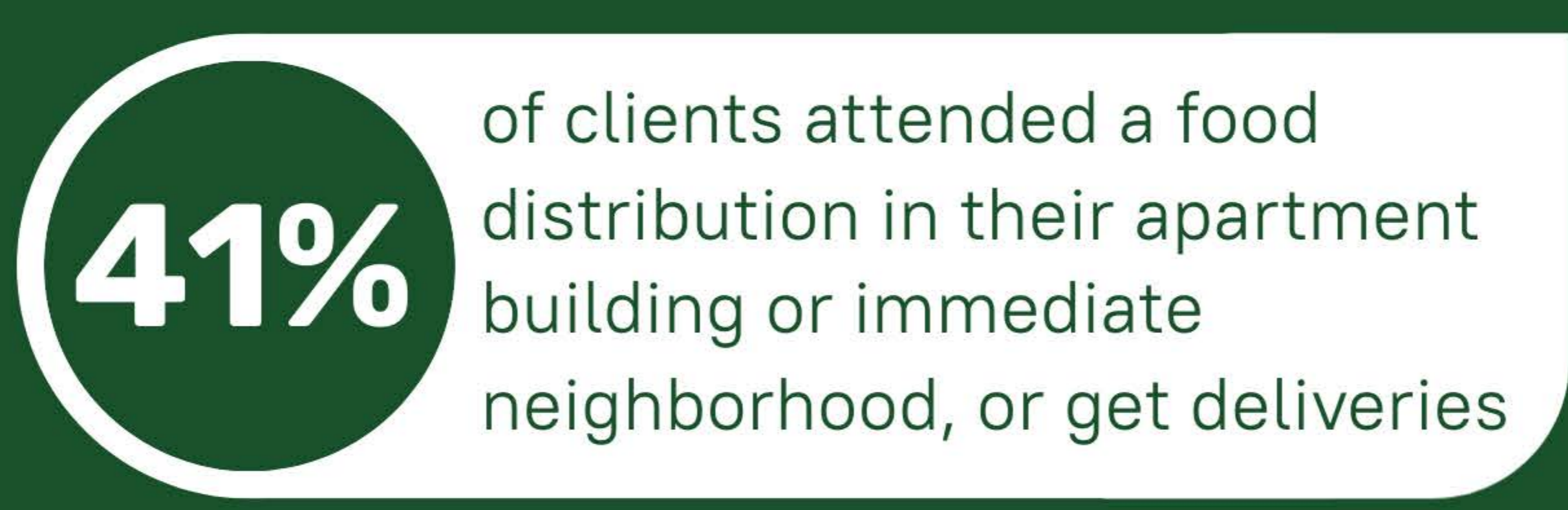
43% were single individuals living alone

Most Common Primary Languages of AFAC Clients



AFAC managed **20 weekly food distribution centers** and held **1,246** food distribution events in one year



AFAC Home Delivery Program (FY23)



AFAC delivered weekly groceries to **181 (2.75%) households**



The program supports Arlington County's **most vulnerable** population gain reliable access to nutritious groceries



To qualify, participants are **homebound due to a physical disability or mental illness** that prevents them from leaving the home unassisted



Delivery orders are customized to **meet the participants' unique dietary needs**
