



## Arlington Food Assistance Center (AFAC) Sample Language for Bequests

### **Specific Bequest:**

I give, devise and bequeath (*specific dollar amount, specific item of property, or specific percentage of my adjusted gross estate*) to the Arlington Food Assistance Center (Tax ID #54-1473207), located at 2708 S. Nelson Street, Arlington, Virginia 22206, to be used for its general support.

### **Residuary Bequest:**

I give, devise and bequeath (*all or state a percentage*) of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, both real and personal to the Arlington Food Assistance Center (Tax ID #54-1473207), located at 2708 S. Nelson Street, Arlington, Virginia 22206, to be used for its general support.

### **Contingency Gift (if beneficiary does not survive testator):**

If (*name of beneficiary*) does not survive me, or shall die during the administration of my estate, or as a result of a common disaster, then I give to the Arlington Food Assistance Center (Tax ID #54-1473207), located at 2708 S. Nelson Street, Arlington, Virginia 22206, (*specific dollar amount, specific property, or "all of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both real and personal"*), to be used for its general support.

### **Restricted Gift Bequest with Safety Language:**

I give, devise and bequeath (*specific dollar amount, specific item of property, or specific percentage of my adjusted gross estate*) to the Arlington Food Assistance Center (Tax ID #54-1473207), located at 2708 S. Nelson Street, Arlington, Virginia 22206, to be used exclusively for (*state specific purpose such as children's programs, food purchases, etc.*). In the event the purposes of this restriction, in the opinion of the Board of Directors of the Arlington Food Assistance Center, or its successor organization, can no longer be served, the Board of Directors may devote the remaining assets exclusively for charitable purposes that: (a) are within the scope of the charitable purposes of the charity; (b) most nearly approximate the original purpose of the gift; and (c) benefit the charity.
