

FY26 Arlington Food Assistance Center (AFAC) Fact Sheet (Data from end of FY 25)

About

- Mission: To feed our neighbors in need by providing dignified access to nutritious supplemental groceries.
- Providing free weekly groceries allows families to dedicate limited financial resources to other obligations such as housing, utilities, medication, and other basic needs.
- A referral is required to be eligible for our services. Referrals come from the Arlington County Department of Human Services, Arlington Public Schools, and 20 other partner organizations.

Impact: Client Numbers over FY25

- 199,820 total family visits an 84% increase in the last 4 years
- **8,455** distinct families served **20,596** individuals, including **6,822** children (33%) and **2,510** seniors (12%).
- Average over 3,850 families served every week.
- 55% Hispanic/Latino, 19% Black/African American, 11% white

Food Distribution

- **The Choice Model** gives our clients a dignified way to select grocery items that their families will enjoy, including fresh produce, dairy, protein, and pantry staples.
- Over five million pounds of groceries were distributed to families in need last year.
- **30**% of the food distributed is donated from corporate and community food drives, providing families with variety and choice.
- The remaining 70% of food distributed totaling 3.6 million pounds was purchased by AFAC.
- Groceries are distributed at 21 sites across Arlington County.
- A home delivery program serves **214 households** with elderly or disabled family members who do not have a local support system.

Budget

- **AFAC receives no federal or state funding.** Arlington County provides **only 9%** of what it takes to operate AFAC. The remaining **91% comes from private donations.**
- AFAC had an annual budget of \$9.8 million in FY25. The budget for FY26 increased to \$11.7 million.
- Volunteer time: 1,830 individual volunteers gave **51,657 hours** in FY25, valued **\$2.1 million** the equivalent of **25 full-time employees.**
- AFAC's overhead rate in FY25 was 12.5%.
